PLEASE TAKE NOTICE that a Special Election will be held in said City/Township on Tuesday, May 5, 2015. The last day for receiving registrations for the Special Election will be Monday, April 6, 2015. Persons residing in the named City/Township registering after 5:00 p.m. on Monday, April 6, 2015 will not be eligible to vote at the Special Election. Persons planning to register must determine when the office of the City Clerk or the Township Clerk or the office of the County Clerk or the Secretary of State Branch office will be open for registration in person. Registration may also be made at the specified agency for clients receiving services through the Department of Human Services, the Department of Community Health, Department of Career Development and at the military recruitment offices for persons enlisting in the armed forces. Registration by mail may be used by obtaining and completing a Mail Voter Registration Application and forwarding to the election official as directed on the application by the close of registration deadline. A person who registers to vote by mail is required to vote in person unless they have previously voted in person in the city/township where they live or are at least 60 years of age or are handicapped. Only persons who have registered as electors with the appropriate City Clerk, Township Clerk, County Clerk or through registration at a Secretary of State Branch office or at any specified agency or military recruitment office or by using an official mail registration application, are registered electors of the named City/Township.

PERSONS ENTITLED to be registered voters in said City/Township must possess the following qualifications on or before the day of the Election: (1) a citizen of the United States; (2) not less than 18 years of age; (3) a resident of the State of Michigan and the local municipality for not less than 30 days prior to the Election (MCL 168.492). In addition, qualified electors must be registered to vote not less than 30 days prior to the Election (MCL 168.497).

PROPOSAL 15-1

A PROPOSAL TO AMEND THE STATE CONSTITUTION TO INCREASE THE SALES/USE TAX FROM 6% TO 7% TO REPLACE AND SUPPLEMENT REDUCED REVENUE TO THE SCHOOL AID FUND AND LOCAL UNITS OF GOVERNMENT CAUSED BY THE ELIMINATION OF THE SALES/USE TAX ON GASOLINE AND DIESEL FUEL FOR VEHICLES OPERATING ON PUBLIC ROADS, AND TO GIVE EFFECT TO LAWS THAT PROVIDE ADDITIONAL MONEY FOR ROADS AND OTHER TRANSPORTATION PURPOSES BY INCREASING THE GAS TAX AND VEHICLE REGISTRATION FEES.

911 OPERATING SURVCHARGE REAUTHORIZATION PROPOSAL

Shall the County of Presque Isle, Michigan, be authorized to assess a 9-1-1 charge at a rate not to exceed \$1.00 each month, subject to reduction as provided by law, to each service user located within the geographic boundaries of Presque Isle, Michigan, for a period of five (5) years, July 1, 2015, through June 30, 2020, both inclusive, to maintain and operate the 9-1-1 system in the County of Presque Isle, Michigan.
